What is a Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA)?

The CHNA is an assessment of the Health Need of a given community as identified by local healthcare experts and community members. Non profit hospitals are required by the Federal Government to conduct a CHNA every 3 years.

- 3. Insurance Affordability
- 4. Diabetes
- 5. Cancer
- 6. Behavioral Health
- 7. Heart Disease
